The Gut Check program was developed to instill leadership and discipline to middle school males. Done so in a structured yet high-energy environment, the program utilizes principles such teamwork, communication, motivation, and humility through physical participation. The program is held during the summer months at North Georgia College, where the participants are housed for the duration. Beginning on a Thursday evening and concluding with a graduation ceremony on Sunday afternoon, the students participate in many activities including a ropes course, obstacle course, and rappelling at Mount Yonah. Besides the activities, the participants will hear from a variety of speakers such as coaches, military personnel, and law enforcement personnel who can give encouragement, guidance, and in some cases a much needed insight to life.

Rules for InteractiveAngler.com Charity Tournament benefiting Gainesville Jaycees Gut Check Program

1. Contestant/Entrant agrees to procure reasonable property and personal liability insurance for all activities related to Contestant's participation in this Tournament. Contestant shall assume all risk of injury or death and loss of personal property which may result from participation in the Tournament and hereby releases and discharges InteractiveAngler.com, Gainesville Jaycees, event Sponsor(s), other participants and their respective officers, directors, officials, representatives, agents, employees, volunteers and all others associated with this event, from any and all liability, obligation, loss, damages, claims or causes of action in any way resulting from or arising out of the Tournament or related activities. Contestant grants this release and discharge with full knowledge and awareness of the inherent danger associated with competitive fishing events such as this Tournament.
2. To participate and be eligible for this Tournament, a properly completed and signed application is required for each entry to the Tournament. Any person entering the Tournament that is not **18 years of age** must fish with an adult and have written permission to fish. This written permission must be from the Contestant's parent or legal guardian and submitted with the under-aged Contestant's application.
3. All boats and motors must meet all United States Coast Guard requirements. Safe boating will be observed at all times. Each Contestant is required to wear a **fastened, U.S. Coast Guard approved, personal flotation device** anytime the combustion engine is in operation. All boats must be equipped with an **emergency shut-off device**, and must be attached to the driver's body when the combustion engine is in operation. All boats must have a **working aerated livewell** (can be a portable aerator). This will be examined during bat inspection process.
4. Tournament may be shortened or canceled due to unsafe weather or water conditions. The decision to shorten or to cancel will be at the full discretion of the Tournament Officials. Location is also subject to change due to ramp conditions on the day of the tournament, so makes sure to list phone number on app.
5. All Contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy and conservation and to conduct themselves in a manner that will be a credit to themselves, to InteractiveAngler.com, the Tournament organization and sponsors, and to the Gainesville Jaycees. No alcoholic beverages or mind-altering substances are allowed during Tournament hours, this includes pre-tournament and all tournament activities.
6. In consideration for permission to participate in the Tournament, I ("Contestant") here by grant to the Tournament, to InteractiveAngler.com and to Gainesville Jaycees the unconditional right to use my name, voice, and photograph likeness in the presentation and promotion of future Tournaments and other events or activities, which benefit Gainesville Jaycees. I understand that I will not be entitled to receive any royalties or other compensation in connection with such use.
7. Take-off positions will be given out the day of the tournament. Blast-Off position is determined when the entry fee is received, **either by mail by Wednesday, April 28, 2010, by email or fax by Friday, April 30, 2010 or at the ramp on the morning of the tournament.** Tournament hours will be from: **(Safe-Light) to 3:00 PM for first flight** unless otherwise stated prior to the tournament start. Flights will be limited to 20 boats and be separated by 10-minute increments.
8. Protests must be filed in writing to the tournament director prior to weigh-in. Tournament Committee will rule on all protests and their decision is final.
9. Only artificial lures may be used, NO live bait, NO trolling. All Bass must be caught live and in a conventional manner with a rod and reel while fishing in the boat. Angler fishing must cease if out of the boat for any reason.
10. The limit shall be five (5) Bass per boat.. All Bass must be a minimum Fourteen (14) inches in length, measured on a "Golden Rule" flat board with the mouth closed and moving the tail side to side.
11. There will be a one-quarter (.25) pound penalty per fish for bringing **dead fish** to the scales. A **short fish** brought to the weigh-in **will result in the loss of the team's big bass. Culling of fish shall be done immediately upon landing the sixth (6) keeper. Under no circumstances shall a team have more than five (5) fish in their livewell or the team will be disqualified.** The tournament director may be asked to provide a courtesy measurement prior to a team turning their fish over to the weigh-in committee.
12. **There shall be "one official checkpoint" for boat checkout in the morning and check-in in the afternoon. Failure to go through boat checks will result in disqualification.**
13. Teams who are not in the official weigh-in area at the appointed times will be penalized one (1) pound for each minute they are late starting with their Big Bass. Any team more than five (5) minutes late shall be disqualified.
14. There will be NO official practice or off-limits period prior to the event. Off-Limits fishing areas will be the whole area inside the buoys at the ramp site. Fishing on tournament waters is permitted except within fifty **50** yards of a Marina gas dock or another competitor's boat, which is anchored, and the trolling motor is up.
15. As a contestant in this tournament, I hereby consent to a polygraph examination by an operator solely selected by the tournament officials, and I agree that the results of said examination will be the final decision.
16. Interpretation of these rules shall be left exclusively to InteractiveAngler.com and Gainesville Jaycees tournament officials. The decision of the tournament director shall be final in all matters. Infraction of these rules may be grounds for disqualification for this and future events. Tournament officials reserve the right to refuse any applicant without cause.
